off and pick up times when collecting.



Can we imagine a world without Love? Can we survive in this life without love? Even if there are ups and downs in in our relations, ultimately Love is the driving force.

When we speak about true love the reflection of Shakespeare is very interesting: "Love that changes when circumstances change is not love. It is mere sensuality or lust. Once two true minds get united in love, nothing can change or separate them. No remover can remove, can even bend true love. In other words, no external force or influence, however strong, can sever the bond between true minds united in love."

In the gospel and in the second reading John expresses the depth of God's love for us. It is simple and everlasting. He calls us to love one another, as God loves him and as he loves us and be the friend of God. Jesus explains that we will be happy and fulfilled only when we keep this command - Love one another.

God's love is revealed to us through the works of God. Creation and redemption are expressions of this love. Every call of God, every initiative of God, every intervention of God is a manifestation of God's great love. The greatest expression of God's love is the death of Jesus to save humanity.

The readings explain the characteristics of God's love, that is, universality. God loves everyone. The gospel also indicates that joy is one of the consequences of love.

How can we remain in the love of God? One of the essential requirements to remain in the love of God is obedience. Obedience of God's law of Love: Love God, Love each other. However, it's not always so easy. This love may requires putting others first and giving up a special treat or being a friend to someone who is not so easy to love.

Love in the Gospel is not a feeling about another person, but a choice to seek the good of the other person even if I must sacrifice my own good. We have the power to live that way once we recognize God's love for us and His choice to share His life with us.

May God help us to reflect the true Christian culture, that we are reflections of God's love.Lord's Blessing, Fr Regi


